### MEETING MINUTES: "QUESTIONS & DISCUSSION"

**Question:** Which days will overnight construction work be occurring?

**Answer:** The specific dates are not known at this time, however overnight work schedules will be highlighted in the two week look ahead notices.

**Question:** When will the ferry be running overnight?

**Answer:** The ferry is not currently being used for construction and hasn't been used for construction in about 1.5 months. The TPA noted that under certain extreme weather conditions the ferry will idle overnight while being monitored by staff to ensure safety and avoid equipment damage.

**Question:** Henio asked Jen Chan if the noise by-law permitting work between the hours of 7am and 7pm has changed.

**Answer:** Jen noted that the by-law has not changed. The City by-law permits construction activity between 7am-7pm, Monday to Friday and 9am-7pm on Saturday.

**Question:** When is the tunnel construction going to be complete?

**Answer:** Target service commencement is summer 2014.

**Question:** Who is responsible for advertising in the tunnel?

**Answer:** Ken Lundy to connect with Carol Jolly as the protocol for advertisement becomes more developed.

**Question:** Is there an opportunity for community advertising (to be managed by BIA) in the tunnel?

**Answer:** Carol Jolly to follow up with Ken Lundy following TCC meeting.

**Question:** Marilyn requested a reminder notice be sent to subcontractors operating trucks overnight that Bathurst is to be used rather than Stadium Road.

**Answer:** Project Co will send a reminder to all its subcontractors.

**Question: Do the fuel trucks use Bathurst and are fuel trucks capable of making the turn on Bathurst?**

Answer: Fuel trucks make deliveries to the airport on a regular basis. Service providers have been advised to use Bathurst Street and avoid residential side streets. Routes are reviewed by the service provider to ensure they are proper and adequate to handle the delivery vehicles.

**Question: Heino noted that he has noticed trucks on Friday evening (not necessarily associated with the tunnel construction).**

Answer: TPA noted that they are willing to work with the community in determining what the trucks are associated with; TPA cameras can be used to identify the trucks.
