MEETING MINUTES: “QUESTIONS & DISCUSSION”

Question: What are going to be the hours of construction when work is being done at or above grade?

Answer: The hours of construction will be in compliance with the City By-Laws and PCL’s agreement with the City which permits certain work from 7AM to 11PM.

Question: What is the recent status of trucks on the local streets and at the job site?

Answer: The community members noted that an improvement has been noticed.

Question: Hal noted that he has periodically been woken up between the hours of 2:45AM and 3:45AM. He has kept a log of the events which he intends to send to Gene Cabral. Hal described the sound as a constant hum. Is there any equipment operating around the ferry terminal during these hours?

Answer: PCL has not had any on site activities during these hours

Question: The community members requested that each of the future TCC meetings be evaluated for necessity prior to holding the meeting. Is there a strategy that ensures proper community channels are available while considering everyone’s time?

Answer: The Committee agreed that going forward the meeting materials and updates will be sent to all committee members two weeks prior to the regularly scheduled meeting. If the community members indicate, within one week, the desire to attend a meeting in-person, the regularly scheduled meeting will be held, otherwise the next in-person meeting will be postponed to the next regularly scheduled meeting.

Question: How is the backfilling of the island excavation going to be done? Are there any noise considerations transporting the material back from the storage area on the airport?

Answer: The backfill will be placed by crane or directly from dump trucks. The backfilling process is not anticipated to be a noisy activity and will follow the same noise mitigation strategies implemented during the hauling of material to the Toronto Port Authority stockpile location. Additional details on noise considerations and the scheduling of works will be provided in a few months when the backfilling process commences.

Question: What are the noise considerations for the ventilation system? Is there any information that can be shared with the committee on the ventilation systems? Is there going to be noise barriers?

Answer: There is no noise barriers required on this project. The operating outside noise levels will be similar to the Harbourfront community centre.

Question: Have the elevators/escalators been reviewed for vibrational impacts? Are there any potential noise concerns?

Answer: The elevators and escalators are the same as what you see in any office building. There is no vibration or noise from this equipment.

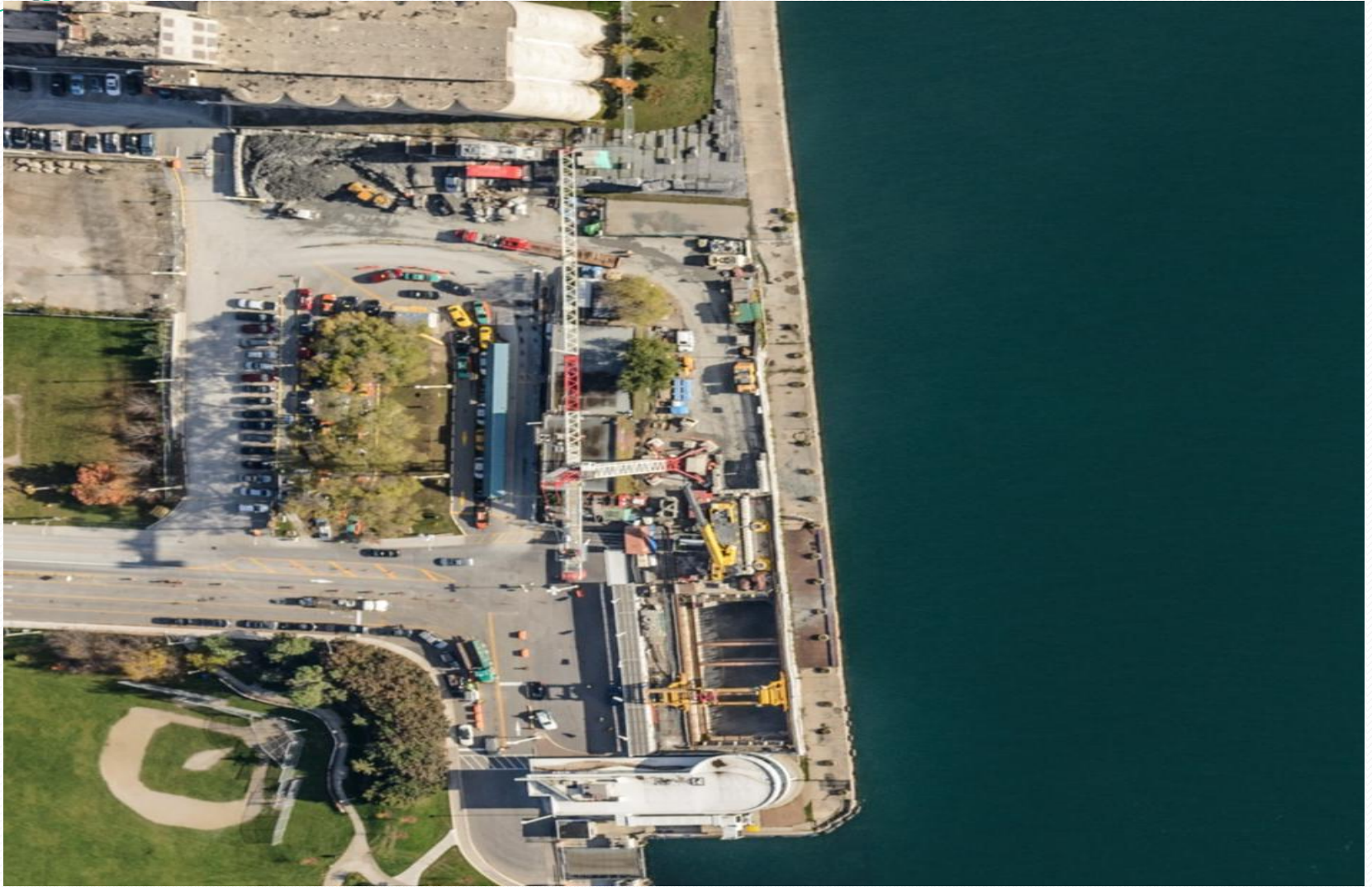
